## REspect! as a reporting portal and its approach

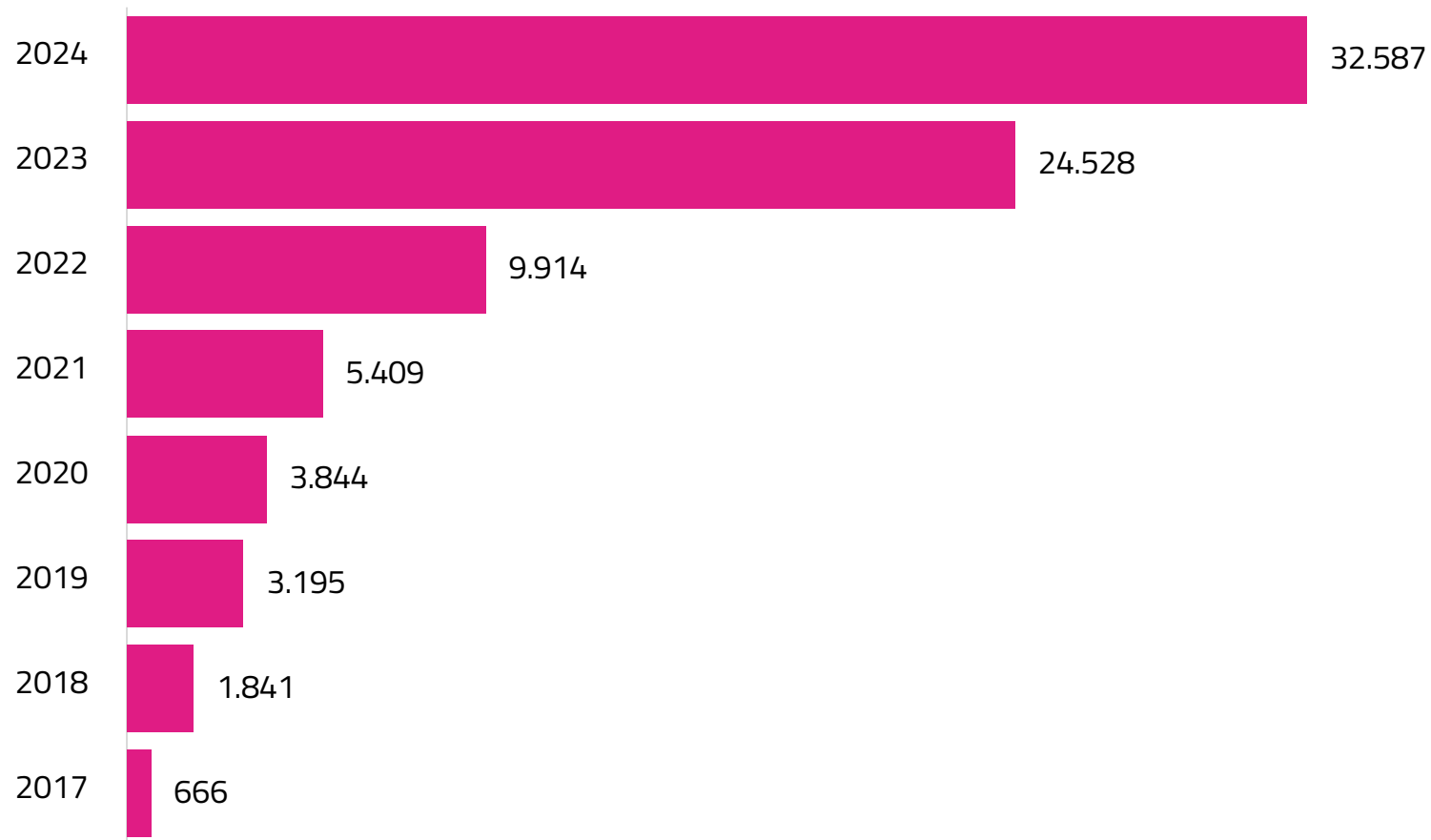
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REspect! as a Reporting portal of the Baden-Württemberg Youth Foundation is committed to promoting fair and responsible behavior online. REspect! is a low-threshold partner, especially for victims and all who are engaged and willing to take on responsibility. We believe same rules should apply online as in the analogue world. REspect! refers individuals to counseling services, showing where help and support are available if someone feels threatened or intimidated.

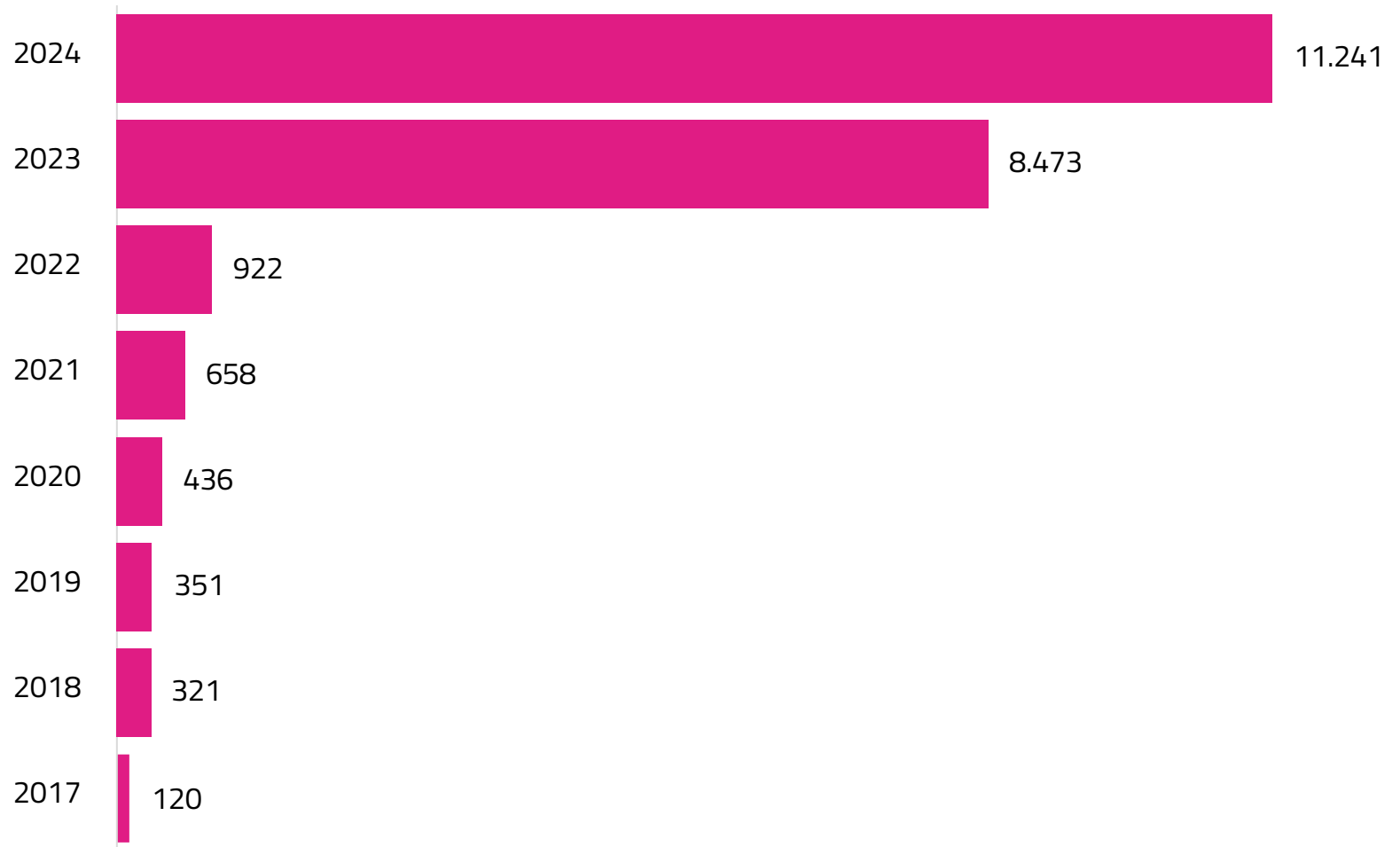
Reports that are classified as potentially relevant under criminal law are forwarded to the Federal Criminal Police Office in Germany (BKA) for further review. The BKA then involves the responsible state criminal police offices. If the initial suspicion is confirmed during this legal review, REspect! has the opportunity to submit a deletion request to the platforms.

Since October 1, 2024, REspect! has been certified by the Digital Services Coordinator in Germany as a trusted flagger under the European Digital Services Act. This means that deletion requests submitted by REspect! to platforms must be prioritized and processed quickly by the platforms.

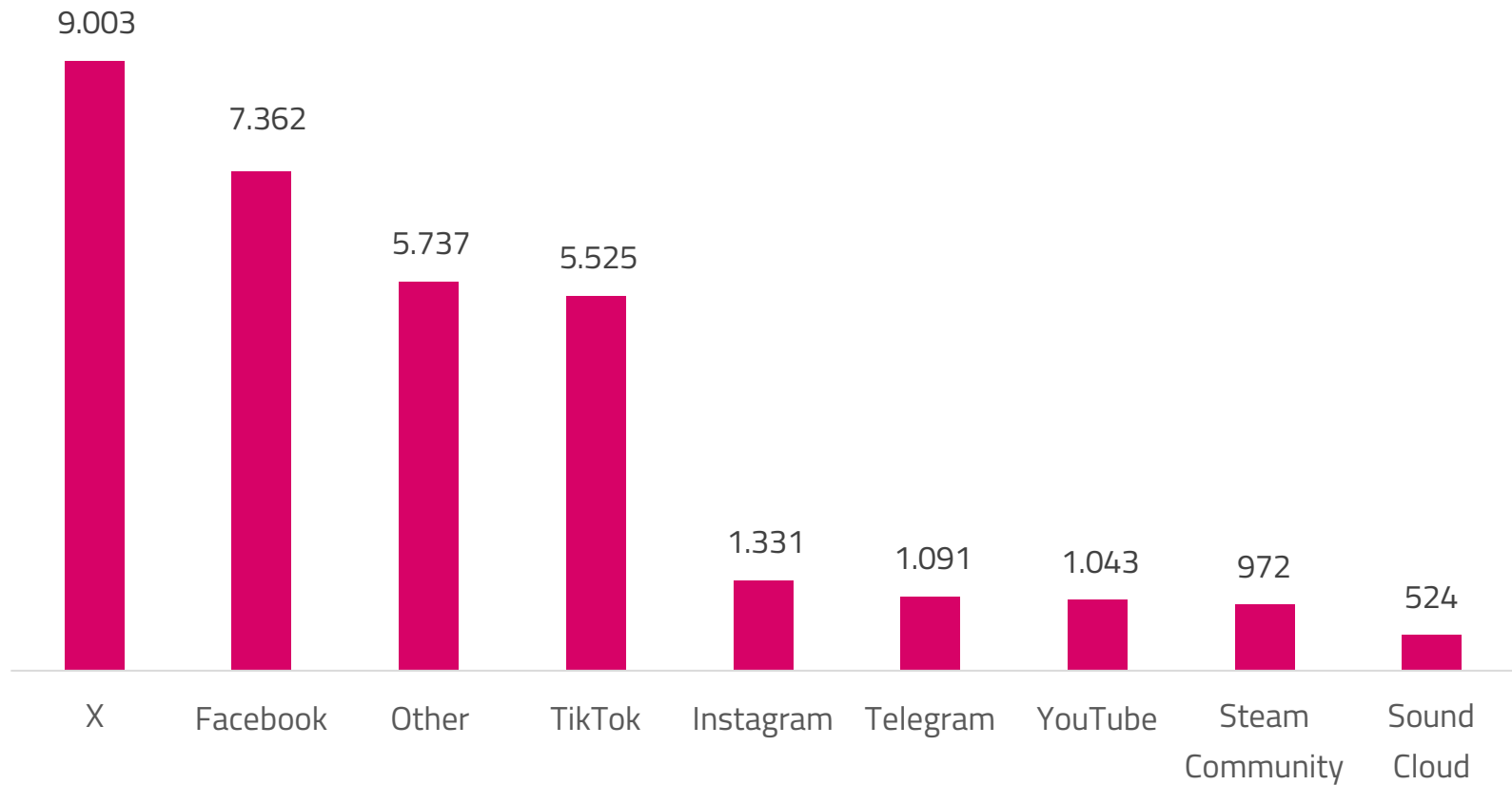
# Incoming reports per year
